



EXPANDED CURBSIDE RECYCLING OPTIONS

We've made recycling easier for Norwalk's residents and we hope you take this opportunity to recycle more! *Norwalk saves over \$90 each time a ton of recycling is collected instead of garbage – just think of what those dollars could be used for instead of garbage disposal.* And it is so great for our environment too!

<p><u>PAPER</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Newspaper • Junk mail • Magazines • Office paper • Paperboard (like cereal boxes) • Phonebooks 	<p><u>GREEN BIN OPTION</u></p> <p>As an option to help you recycle more, you can now use a separate GREEN BIN for all of your mixed paper instead of using paper bags or tying in bundles.</p> <p>Bins may be purchased at the Norwalk Transfer Station on Crescent Street.</p> <p>Place the GREEN BIN beneath or next to your BLUE BIN.</p> <p>Corrugated cardboard should still be flattened and bundled.</p>
<p><u>COMMINGLED CONTAINERS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastics #1 thru #7 • Milk and juice cartons • Metal cans, plates and food packages • Aluminum foil • Glass bottles and jars used to package food and beverages 	<p><u>BLUE BIN</u></p> <p>Norwalk has expanded its curbside recycling program to include Plastics #3 thru #7 in addition to the #1 and #2s collected. Check the number in the small triangle on the cleaned item before placing in your BLUE BIN.</p>

✓ **Did you know you can now recycle electronics, oil, antifreeze, tires, large and rigid plastics (children's toys, laundry baskets, etc.), and batteries at the Norwalk Transfer Station?**
